

WHAT IS THE WESENSEIT APPLICATION?

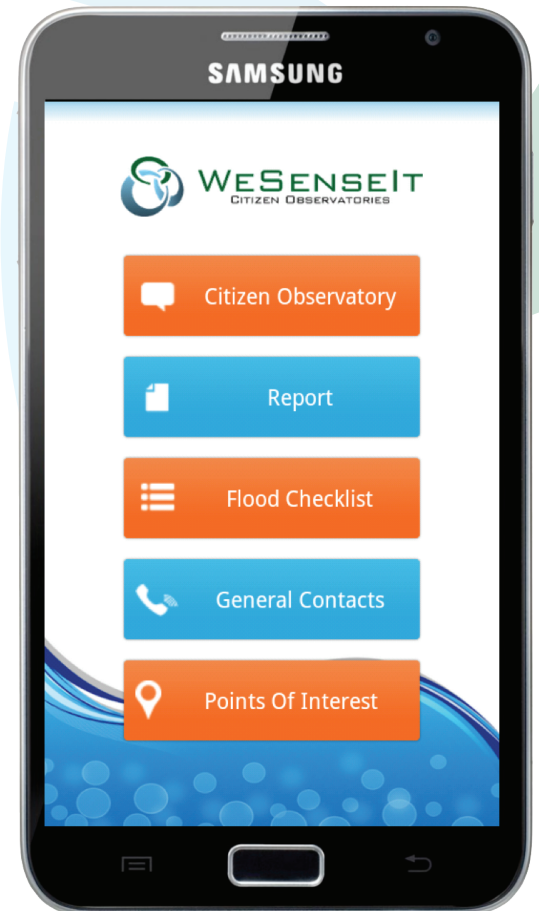

The WeSenseit app aims to provide such a channel, where you can communicate directly with Doncaster City Council to help contribute to the decision making process. This will ensure crisis responders can act on the most up-to-date information about what is happening in your local area.

Through the use of the WeSenseit app you will have a direct impact in many aspects of the response to crisis situations. Primarily, you will:
